WHAT'S NEW & WHAT'S HAPPENING FOR 2018/19

MONSTROUS TERRAIN & NEW ACCESS

Last winter, Panorama welcomed a 128-acre (52 hectare) expansion to Taynton Bowl, the resort's off-piste backcountry-style terrain. It was the first phase of a multi-stage terrain expansion, opening up a new alpine zone to skiers and riders. This year skiers will be able to access the highest point of this terrain by a custom built, 13 passenger snowcat. The Monster X, equipped with plush seating and a pumping sound system, will offer a journey up that's just as much fun as the descent that follows.

A new first tracks experience will also be offered with exclusive early access to Panorama's steep and deep terrain from the village via the Monster X snowcat with breakfast en-route included.

\$1 MILLION INVESTED INTO IMPROVED SNOWMAKING & GROOMING

The 2018/19 winter season will see further improvements to Panorama's snowmaking technology and award-winning grooming. The resort has one of the largest snowmaking systems in North America, and this season has invested close to \$1 million in state-of-the- art snowmaking and grooming technology. This is in addition to the \$700k investment in snowmaking automation and capacity last year.

For the first time the resort undertook an extensive summer slope grooming program using a specialized mower to trim vegetation on all main trails so that they now need less snow to open.

Two new Prinoth winch snow grooming machines will ensure that the resort will buff-out more piste each night than ever before.

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POWERED UP DINING & APRÈS SKI

Panorama is renowned for its boutique alpine dining scene, and this year the resort is kicking things up a notch with the addition of the first snowcat food truck in Canada. A professional kitchen installed on a Prinoth snow groomer, the Snowlicious Mobile Kitchen will roam the mountain and offer a casual alfresco experience right on the slopes. On-mountain après dining will take on a new spin with the Monster X transporting guests to multi-course fondue dinner at the Mile 1 Hut or Raclette at the intimate Elkhorn Cabin.

A new culinary team headed by Austrian-export, David Auer, is also re-imagining the resort dining experience with new menus and concepts rolling out over the season in the various resort restaurants.

UNLIMITED ADVENTURE PLAYGROUND

Panorama offers guests a variety of ways to push their boundaries. With RK Heliski departing right from the village it's easy to imagine being whisked away by helicopter into 1500 square kilometres of BC's finest backcountry terrain, and some of the highest heli-landings in the country. Visitors can also explore the deep powder bowl, Paradise, and tour the remnants of an abandoned 1900's silver mine by snowmobile. Fat-tire biking, snowshoeing and Nordic ski trails extend into the quiet wilderness around the resort. Or how about launching directly from the slopes, skis still on, with your tandem paraglide pro. All of these activities are offered directly from the resort, making it easy to create an itinerary packed full of adventure.
